



Addendum to 2024 RER Sailing Instructions No 2 – 23 May 2024

Original Sailing Instruction

“16.4. Yachts must record a). the time at which the Greenwich Meridian light vessel is at a bearing of 90° true and b). the approximate distance from the Greenwich Meridian light vessel when the time is recorded, which must be entered on the Declaration Form (SI 17).”

Amended Sailing Instruction

Paragraph 16.4 is amended in its entirety to:

“16. 4 Yachts must record the time that they cross the line of latitude 50° 25.000’N

There is no requirement to cross this line at a prescribed distance from Greenwich Meridian Light Vessel.

This time should be recorded on your declaration form (SI 17), preferably yachts should record the time by taking an image of a GPS device at the time of crossing.

Your race committee may use these times to calculate a set of results for a sub class of the Royal Escape Race.

This change does **not** constitute a shortened course, yachts should continue to the finish line at Fécamp.”
